## Two-Volume Publication by Nirenstein Shows New Shopping Centers

Delivery is now being made of the two-volume publication of Nathan Nirenstein's preferred real estate locations. Published by Nirenstein's National Realty Map Company of Springfield, Mass., the two large books are Volumes XIV and XIV-A of the series Mr. Nirenstein has been compiling on business locations.

One volume contains nineteen sections of New York City. It contains old and new scenes in Manhattan along with the editorial matter. Maps show percentage locations with names of owners and lessees. They also give the heights of the buildings and the assessed valuation of both the land and the building.

The second volume shows shopping areas of Kew Gardens, Forest Hills and Jamaica in Queens, Hempstead, L. I.; White Plains, N. Y.; West Hartford, Conn., and Boston, Mass.

Maps and other data are furnished on a number of decentralized shopping centers. They include Biscayne Boulevard in Miami and the Sunrise Shopping Center in Fort Lauderdale, Fla.; Roosevelt Field on Long Island, the Cross County Center in Yonkers, N. Y.; Bishops Corner in Hartford, Conn., and the Chestnut Hill Shopping Center in Newton, Mass.

Also, the Mid-Island Shopping Center in Hicksville, L. I.; Northland Center in Detroit, Mich., and the Shoppers World in Framingham, Mass.

The history of each city and its principal industries are listed. Aerial views are also provided. The maps are printed on large pages.

The two books are intended primarily for banks, chain stores, institutional and individual investors, governmental agencies and real estate brokers. The two are sold together for \$495.

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
